

SMB

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The smb worker enables you to browse the shares of a Windows® (or Samba) network.

To see the workgroups, enter **smb:/** .

smb:// a_workgroup will list the hosts in this workgroup.

To see the shares of a host, enter **smb:// the_host** or **smb:/ a_workgroup / the_host**.

To access a share directly enter **smb:// the_host/the_share** or **smb:/ a_workgroup / the_host / the_share**

The smb worker requires that you have libsmbclient to use this worker.

You can set your default user name and password in the System Settings category **Network in Connectivity** → **Windows Shares**. This is especially useful if you are a member of a Windows® NT domain. There you can also set your workgroup name, but in most cases this is not required. The worker will ask for your username and password if a default is not set.
